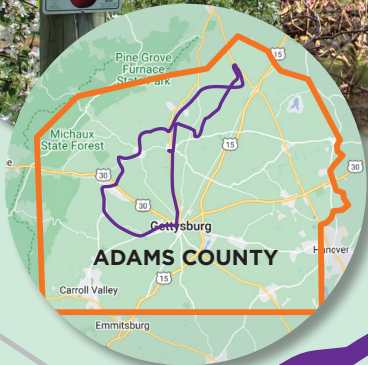


# ADAMS COUNTY BLOSSOM BELT MAP

**E**very Spring, Pennsylvania's Adams County Blossom Belt comes to life in a sea of pink and white as 20,000 acres of fruit orchards burst forth into a breathtaking landscape.

Over the rolling hills and fertile valleys of northern and western Adams County, the first sign of the season comes in late March. A bud — likely an apricot or plum — sparks a weeks-long explosion of color, a dazzling display of billions of blossoms, hitting their peak as the region's abundant apple varieties take form.

Through mid-May, peach, pear, and cherry trees bloom among apple blossoms in scenic orchards primed for your best photo ops. Fresh and fragrant breezes fill the air, tempting you to stop and soak in the wonders of spring like you've never experienced it before.

## WHERE TO GO FOR BLOSSOMS



The tip of the Adams County Blossom Belt is within a 10-minute drive from historic downtown Gettysburg.

A good way to time your springtime journey is by the blossoms at Gettysburg National Military Park's Peach Orchard. Their blooms usually signal that Blossom Belt trees are getting ready to pop.

This map suggests routes to places where blossoms are plentiful. Along the way, stop and take in the scenery. There's plenty to do at one of the county's many farm markets. Enjoy unique places to eat. Schedule a carriage ride or wine tasting. Don't miss the Adams County Blossom Festival.
